

CONTEST REGULATION - THAT'S MY IDEA

- **Art. 1 – Purpose**

The contest is dedicated to all young musicians and songwriters under the age of 30. The contest intends to reward those who demonstrate creative and technical skills such as to lay the foundation of professional development.

- **Art. 2 – Recipients**

The contest is open to all the residents of one of the countries of the European Community. The age of songwriters and performers cannot exceed 30 years. The same applies as the average age of the members of each band.

- **Art. 3 – Type of works admitted to the contest**

Participants will be able to submit to the jury works carried out in full expressive autonomy. The contest rules require all competitors to submit an unreleased song.

- **Art. 4 – Presentation of the works**

Participants are invited to send their unreleased song no later than midnight on 25 May 2022 at the following link:

- **Art. 5 – Privacy and disclaimer**

The works sent will not be returned and will remain available to the organizing committee, which reserves the right to produce information material with the contributions sent, without paying any remuneration or compensation to the authors, except for the proceeds deriving from the economic exploitation of the works. Sending the work for participation in the competition implies the possession of all the rights of the work itself (Art. 3), and relieves the promoters of the Contest from all responsibilities, costs and charges of any nature, which may be incurred due to the content of the works. The works produced must be received accompanied by the consent to the processing of personal data pursuant to art. 13 REG. 2016/679, referred to in the relevant form, an integral part of this Regulation.

- **Art. 6 – Evaluation**

The material sent will be examined by a commission of experts composed of an internationally renowned musical author, a representative of the project leader association, Codici Centro per i Diritti del Cittadino (Italy), a representative of the LTCA - Lithuanian Consumers Alliance (Lithuania), project partner, and a member of the EUIPO,

- **Art. 7 – Award**

The 3 winners will be entitled to legal and administrative assistance for the registration and protection of their work. The first classified will also have the opportunity to participate in Campus Band (<https://www.campusband.it>), a music competition where 12 artists, including the winner of the That's My Idea Contest, will perform during a great show that will be specially set up in a suitable space and will be held in occasion of the celebrations of the end of the school year. A jury made up of 15 people chosen from among the public present at the competition, and by the members of the Campus Band commission of experts, through an

open vote will decide the final winner of the competition, chosen from the bands, songwriters and performers, and will assign a scholarship to the competitors who will receive the highest number of votes in their respective categories. Successful artists are expected to participate in the final as guests.

- **Art. 9 – Acceptance of the Regulation**

Participation in the contest is considered as full acceptance of this Regulation.
