

Information and Personal-Data Access Pursuant to Art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679

(General Data Protection Regulation)

Dear participant,

You have received this information pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), as you have provided personal data to CODICI CENTRO PER I DIRITTI DEL CITTADINO, which is based at VIA BELLUZZO 1, ROMA. CODICI CENTRO PER I DIRITTI DEL CITTADINO is the Data Controller and requires your personal information to manage its selection procedures. In accordance with the GDPR, your personal data will be processed fairly, lawfully and transparently, as well as in a manner that safeguards your privacy and your rights.

We are therefore providing you with the following information:

a) Identity and contact details of the Data Controller

The Data Controller is “CODICI CENTRO PER I DIRITTI DEL CITTADINO” based in ROMA, Via Belluzzo 1 – Tax Code 96237770589, in the name of its legal representative IVANO GIACOMELLI Tax Code GCMVNI59L14H501K;

b) Purpose of the treatment

The personal data provided are necessary for the participation in the CONTEST THAT'S MY IDEA, as detailed in the relevant Regulation.

c) Methods of treatment and conservation

The processing of the data you provide is carried out both in an automated and manual form in compliance with the provisions of art. 32 of the G.D.P.R. 2016/679, by persons specifically appointed and in compliance with the provisions of Article 29 of the G.D.P.R. 2016/679. We point out that, in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimization, pursuant to art. 5 of the G.D.P.R. 2016/679, subject to your free and explicit consent expressed in the annex to this information, your personal data will be kept for the period of time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are collected and processed and in any case no later than the established terms. by tax laws, labor and social security regulations and by the relevant civil code and for a further ten years.

d) Communication and dissemination scope

We also inform you that the data collected may be disseminated and may be communicated exclusively for the achievement of the purposes referred to in lett. b) and exclusively to the persons in charge for this purpose or for the necessary communications that may involve the transfer of data to public bodies, consultants or other subjects for the fulfillment of legal obligations. Furthermore, such data may be known, within the limits of current legislation, by employees and / or collaborators expressly appointed and appointed by the Data Controller. It is expressly forbidden the dissemination and communication of data for profiling, commercial and marketing purposes. However, data that can be classified as "particular categories of personal data" will not be collected, that is, data that reveal "racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical conventions, or trade union membership, as well as genetic data, biometric data intended to uniquely identify a natural person, data relating to the health or sexual life or sexual orientation of the person". These categories of data may be processed only with the prior and explicit consent, expressed in writing as an attachment to this information.

e) Rights of the interested party

In relation to the data subject to the processing referred to in this information, the interested party is recognized at any time the right to:

- Access (Article 15 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Correction (Article 16 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Cancellation (Article 17 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Limitation (Article 18 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Portability, understood as the right to obtain from the data controller the data in a structured format of common use and readable by an automatic device to transmit them to another data controller without impediments (Article 20 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Opposition to processing (Article 21 EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Withdrawal of the consent to the processing, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent acquired before the revocation (Article 7, paragraph 3 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679);
- Submit a complaint to the Guarantor Authority for the Protection of Personal Data (Article 51 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679).
